INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Note:


Installation should be in accordance with accepted plumbing practices. Flush all piping thoroughly before installation.

- 1. Turn off hot and cold water supplies.
- 2. Unscrew Bonnet and remove the top assembly.
- 3. Pull out the motor assembly, make sure spring stay inside the body.
- 4. Ensure the inside of the body is free of deposits and debris. Clean as necessary.
- 5. Insert the motor replacement kit into the body.
- 6. Screw Bonnet into the housing. Tighten it to 100 +/- 10 in-lbs.
- 7. Turn on the hot and cold water supplies. Check for leaks.
- 8. Turn on fixture and allow water to flow for 2 minutes.

 Measure water temperature at outlet. If water is not at the desired temperature, adjust as follows:

TO ADJUST TEMPERATURE

- 1. Loosen locknut.
- 2. Turn on fixture and run water for at least two (2) minutes to allow supply temperature to stabilize.
- 3. Turn temperature adjustment stem counter-clockwise for hotter or clockwise for colder outlet temperature.
- Tighten locknut to prevent accidental or unauthorized temperature adjustment.
- 5. Re-check outlet temperature.
